



VETERAN SUICIDE PREVENTION

- Working with the Tampa Bay area's 211 Crisis Center on a campaign to combat veteran suicide by having a day designated as "Suicide Prevention Day" in September and by providing communications from the USDVA to the Crisis Center for funding - <https://www.crisiscenter.com>
- Collaboration of "Get Help Now" phone app – Crisis Centers – Mental Health Providers to all veterans to connect to the Crisis Centers for "Veteran Peer-to-Peer" response and referral to Managing Entity Mental Health Providers. 1st model to launch 11/11/2019 for three-counties in Florida – St. Johns, Brevard, Hillsborough.
