




What is a good first question to ask Monica?

- Have you ever come to The American Legion before?
- Have you ever filed a VA benefits claim before?
- What kinds of issues are you experiencing?



- "Have you ever come to The American Legion before?"
- With "power of attorney" you can look up information about the Veteran in VBMS.
- Use VA Form 21-22 to obtain POA from a Veteran.
- VA Form 21-22 has changed since 2010, so it's a good idea to obtain a new signed form from Monica.






What is the best follow-up question here?

- And that's the only claim you've ever filed?
- Did you appeal any part of that claim?
- I see. I have another question.




- "And that's the only VA claim you ever filed?"
- Try to determine all claims and conditions that Monica has made to VA in the past.
- This information will let you know what form to use if she wants to refile that claim or condition.



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- Wally Worsening.
- Monica is already service connected for a right knee problem.
- She says that her condition has worsened.





What VA fo	orm or forms should Monica file with regards to the right kr	nee claim?
21-526	EZ (Application for Disability Compensation)	
20-099	5 (Supplemental Claim)	
21-413	8 (Statement in Support of Claim)	
21-894	0 (Application for Increased Compensation Based on TDIU)	
20-572	(Request for Change of Address)	
21-414	2 (Authorization to Release Information)	

- VA Forms 21-526EZ, 21-4138, and 21-4142.
- More than a year has passed since the 2010 rating decision became final, so use VA Form 21-526EZ.
- Use 21-4138 for Monica's statements that the right knee condition has become worse.
 - "She is having more trouble with her right knee, including additional loss of range of motion."
- Use 21-4142 because Monica has stated that she receives all medical care through private providers.

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


What do you think is the best response here?

- I understand. Everything you tell me is held in the strictest confidence, and I'm only asking questions to see how I can help you with your VA claims."
- Just tell me."
- "I understand. Nevermind. I have another question."



- "I understand. Everything you tell me is held in the strict confidence, and I'm only asking questions to see how I can help you with your VA claims."
- Show empathy to Veterans who might be uncomfortable answering questions.
- Explain why you're asking a question.
- Table some topics for later discussion, if necessary.



Many people are sensitive about discussing mental health issues and trauma.

- PTSD and Tinnitus.
- Both of these claims were previously denied, and the rating decision became final more than 1 year ago.
- The right knee claim was *granted* more than 1 year ago.
- The fibromyalgia claim was denied less than a year ago.
- Monica has never filed a service connection claim for asthma.



What VA form or forms should you submit in relation to potential PTSD and tinnitus claims?
21-526EZ (Application for Disability Compensation)
20-0995 (Supplemental Claim)
21-4138 (Statement in Support of Claim)
21-8940 (Application for Increased Compensation Based on Unemployability)
21-4142 (Authorization to Disclose Information)
21-686c (Application Request to Add and/or Remove Dependents)

- VA Forms 20-0995, 21-4138, 21-4142.
- If service connection has been denied before, then you must always use a 20-0995 (Supplemental Claim).
- Use 21-4138 for Monica's statements:
 - In-service stress incidents.
 - Present symptoms.
 - Also consider VA Form 21-0781 (Statement in Support of Claim for Service Connection for PTSD).
- Use 21-4142 for private treatment records.


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Do you think Monica should pursue a tinnitus claim? Yes Maybe No

- Probably no.
- While she says that had ringing of the ears in service, Monica denies all current symptoms. There is a low likelihood that VA will grant the claim.
- Save Monica's time and VA effort by focusing on claims that have good chances of success.

- VA Forms 20-0995, 21-4138, 21-4142.
- If service connection has been denied before, then you must always use a 20-0995 (Supplemental Claim).
- Monica must submit new and relevant evidence.
 - 21-4138: any additional lay statements about symptom onset, and their frequency, severity, and duration.
 - 21-4142: private records about her treatment.

Advocacy Tip: Fibromyalgia is a presumptive condition for deployed Gulf War veterans, so ask VA to grant service connection.



What VA form or forms should Monica submit in relation to an asthma claim?

- 21-526EZ (Application for Disability Compensation)
- 20-0995 (Supplemental Claim)
- 21-4138 (Statement in Support of Claim)
- 21-4142 (Authorization to Disclose Information)
- 21-8940 (Application for Increased Compensation Based on
- Unemployability)



- VA Forms 21-526EZ, 21-4138, 21-4142.
- Monica has never filed an asthma service connection claim before, so she must submit 21-526EZ.
- Use 21-4138 to include lay statements about symptom onset and their frequency, severity, and duration.
- Use 21-4142 to obtain relevant private treatment records.



Advocacy Tip: Chronic asthma is a new particulate matter presumptive condition for deployed Gulf War Veterans, so ask VA to grant service connection.

Other Considerations

- Monica states that she works as a nurse, so TDIU should not be claimed.
- An extended discussion might include:
 - Asking if Monica suffered any other injuries in service.
 - Detailed questions if she suffers from any other current disabilities.
 - Questions about her family status, for dependency pay purposes.

Final Tips Before the Veteran Leaves

- ✓ Are all VA forms complete and signed before submitting them to VA?
- ✓ Did you give the Veteran a copy of all documents?
- ✓ Did you set reasonable expectations that the Veteran must attend all VA C&P exams and that VA claim processing takes several months?
- ✓ Did you remind the Veteran to call with questions or when VA mails the Veteran a rating decision?
- ✓ Remember, if the Veteran is not ready to submit a complete VA claim application right away, then consider submitting an Intent to File to VA.
